Thank you for consulting us on the above application.

We have reviewed the information submitted and have the following comments to make:

Flood risk

The planned houses sit within flood zone 1, so we have no flood risk concerns.

The site is almost 200 metres upstream of main river, and so the River Brede is an ordinary watercourse at this point. Approval regarding the appropriate restoration to the River Brede should be sought from the local lead flood authority which in this case will be East Sussex County Council.

Environmental permit - advice to applicant

The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 require a permit to be obtained for any activities which will take place:

- on or within 8 metres of a main river (16 metres if tidal)
- on or within 8 metres of a flood defence structure or culvert (16 metres if tidal)
- on or within 16 metres of a sea defence
- involving quarrying or excavation within 16 metres of any main river, flood defence (including a remote defence) or culvert
- in a floodplain more than 8 metres from the river bank, culvert or flood defence structure (16 metres if it's a tidal main river) and you don't already have planning permission.

Biodiversity protection

We note the requirement for restoration of the River Brede to the satisfaction of the Environment Agency, however the site is approximately 200m upstream of main river, therefore we are not the permitting authority for any works planned. We would be happy to comment on any restoration proposals put forward by the applicant but would not be able to approve them.
